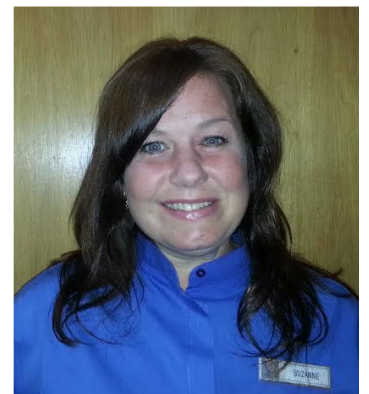
Updates

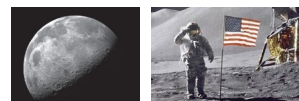

What's Cooking (A summer recipe from our Executive Chef)



Moroccan Lamb Loin Chops

INGREDIENTS *6 servings*

- 6 loin lamb chops
- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 tbs Moroccan Spice
- 1 lemon, wedged

PREPARATION

Preheat grill to high. Brush chops with a little olive oil. Rub spice blend into the chops on both sides.

Grill chops 7 to 8 minutes, turning once, for medium rare, 10 to 12 minutes for medium to medium well. Serve with wedges of lemon.

Serve over bed of Couscous that has Olives, Sundried Tomato and Almonds add for added flavor. Grill some pita bread brush with EVOO and cut in half.
